The Western Daily Press of Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> of June 1947 reported:

"A portrait of Sir Francis Rogers Bart., who married Helena, second daughter of Sir Hugh Smyth, Kt., was sold for £75."

## Who was Sir Francis Rogers?

Francis Rogers was born about 1592, he was the son of Edward Rogers of Cannington in Somerset and his wife Catherine Popham. Francis married Helena Smyth on the 12<sup>th</sup> of October 1615 in Long Ashton. Helena, named after her grand-mother, was the daughter of Sir Hugh Smyth and Elizabeth Gorges. Francis died in August 1638 at the age of 47 and was buried in Long Ashton.
