Aa4226 on the left is an immature male Golden Eagle 'given by the Hon. Mrs Smyth in 1930' (although the catalogue shows an association date of 1902); Aa3100 on the right is an adult female Golden Eagle part of the 'Greville Smyth Collection given in 1925'.

Presumably both birds were originally part of Greville's extensive natural history collection at Ashton Court.
