These two mounted Golden Eagles in a display case can be seen in the Wildlife Gallery of Bristol Museum in Park Street, Bristol.

Aa4226 on the left is an immature male Golden Eagle '*given by the Hon. Mrs Smyth in 1930*' (although the catalogue shows an association date of 1902); Aa3100 on the right is an adult female Golden Eagle part of the '*Greville Smyth Collection given in 1925*'.

Presumably both birds were originally part of Greville's extensive natural history collection at Ashton Court.
